Subject: IMDS prerequisite policy change

Dear Supplier Representative:

Navistar Suppliers, please be advised, effective immediately, Navistar no longer requires submission to the HPE IMDS Database for PPAP. The **only exception** to this would be for specific customer requirements such as the General Motors Vista project. In those cases suppliers will be required to submit into the HPE IMDS database, and obtain appropriate proof of acceptance for PPAP.

Note: In all cases, Navistar continues to require suppliers to certify that their parts meet our restricted material standard, **MPAPS B-50**.

All Part Source Warrant (PSW) forms currently submitted and pending IMDS approval will receive a waiver for IMDS from your SQE.
